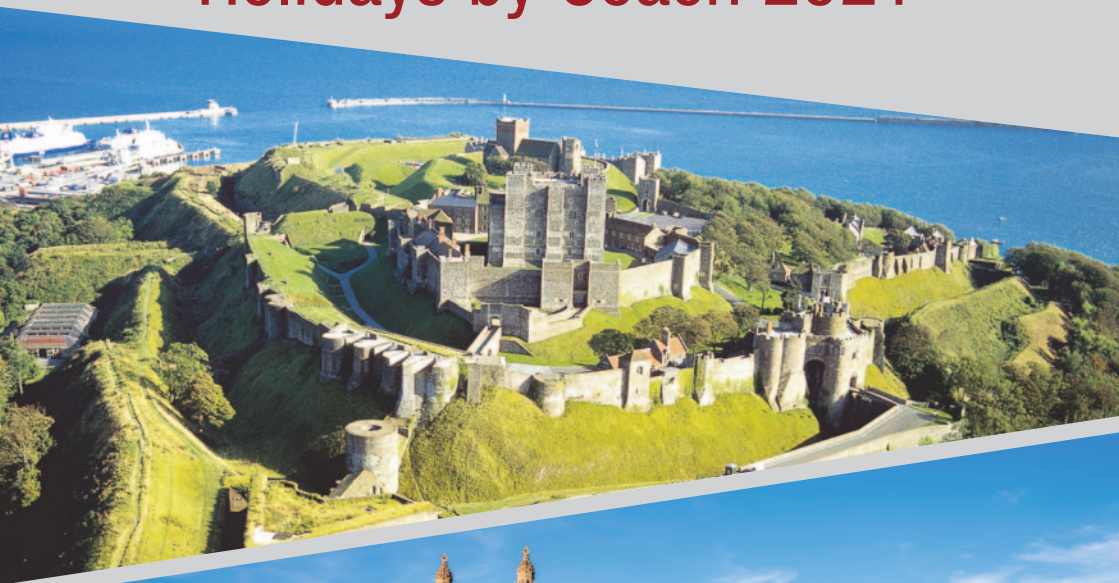

Motorised Scooters, Wheelchair & Walking Aid users



We are happy to carry either one small motorised scooter OR two folding wheelchairs/walkers per departure on a first come first serve basis, this equipment must be booked at the time of first reservation. Each disassembled part of any scooter must not be heavier than 15Kgs and an able-bodied person must be present to assist with the loading/unloading. Each tour in our brochure states how accessible the

holiday would be for a small scooter or wheelchair user by using a "Traffic Light" symbol, Red would be unsuitable in our opinion, Amber would be accessible with limitations and Green would be most suitable. All small scooter & wheelchair users must be accompanied by an able-bodied person and be capable of climbing the stairway into our touring coach. We will always do our best to accommodate each booking, however our free Home Collection Service may not be available to scooter users due to taxi limitations.

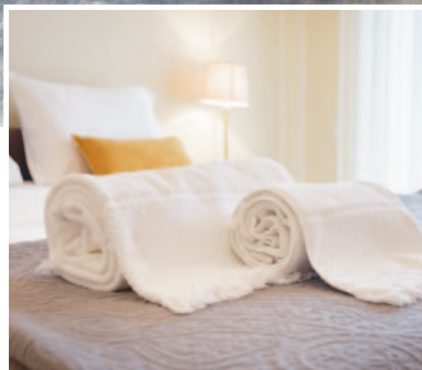

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Glamorous Glasgow

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As Scotland's largest city, Glasgow is famed for its culture, shopping and people. We have included a guided coach tour of this amazing city, highlighting the legacy of Charles Rennie Mackintosh, Scotland's most celebrated architect and designer of the 20th century, complimented with a visit to Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum, one of Scotland's most popular attractions, with 22 themed, state-of-the-art galleries displaying an astonishing 8,000 objects, including Charles Rennie Mackintosh displays. We also enjoy a visit and refreshments at Dumfries House, set in 2,000 acres, this stunning Estate and 18th-century house is one of Britain's most beautiful stately homes. Saved by the intervention of His Royal Highness, Prince Charles, Dumfries House combines the neoclassical architecture of Robert Adam with the furniture of Thomas Chippendale and leading 18th-century Scottish cabinet makers. We also travel north out of the city, crossing the famous Erskine Bridge, a state-of-the-art infrastructure landmark in Scotland



for its time and remains one of the country's most architecturally and technically distinguished bridges of the post-war period and beyond its date of construction, continuing onto Loch Lomond for a peaceful cruise and the opportunity to get to the heart of the Trossachs, with ever-changing scenic vistas which unfold as you meander from picturesque scenery to natural wonders around Loch Lomond.

This year we are heading down to the lovely Solent Hotel & Spa in Fareham, our base for a few days, and an ideal location for our our tours which include a visit to the Hovercraft Museum at Lee on the Solent, a working museum which is constantly restoring, preserving and maintaining the Hovercrafts. We will get to meet the pilot of the Hovercraft who will demonstrate what the 72 seater craft is capable of during our inclusive ride on the Hovercraft across the Solent, passing various forts, for a short visit to the Isle of Wight. Back on dry land, we also visit the Weald & Downland Museum, near Chichester, where we can discover rescued rural homes and buildings, all set in the beautiful landscape of the South Downs National Park. This collection tells the stories of the people who lived and worked in the rural South East over the last 1000 years, including an Anglo Saxon House and an Edwardian Tin Church. It is also home of the TV



show “The Repair Shop” but we can only view the outside sets and buildings used on the programme. Obviously no reunion would be complete without the fun of the Radley Reunion “Travel Show”, games and quizzes and a gift for everyone!

Northumbria's Living History

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Monday 19th April - 5 days ~ 4 night

Northumberland is a magical place filled with ancient castles; hidden gardens; unspoilt beaches; rolling hills; rugged moorland; sweeping views; friendly little market towns and a cultural heritage all of its own. During this tour we visit just a few of the highlights it has to offer, including the historic Hadrian's Wall, which stretches 73 miles (80 Roman miles) across the country from Wallsend in the east to Bowness on the Solway Firth, we view the section of the wall close to Hexham, a charming market town, characterised by its stone architecture, cobbled streets & historic buildings. We also visit the excellent Cragside House & Gardens, former home of the famous inventor, Lord Armstrong. In 1878, Cragside was the first house in the world to be lit by hydro-electricity and it is crammed full of ingenious gadgets. Obviously, our tour wouldn't be complete without a trip to Beamish Open Air Museum, set in

300 acres of beautiful County Durham countryside, it tells the story of life in North East England during the decades.

Slayley Hall Hotel

Slayley Hall Hotel, an Edwardian mansion with a modern twist, set in the stunning Northumberland countryside. All of the guestrooms are en suite & contain the usual refinements including Wifi, TV & refreshment facilities. It also boasts luxury leisure facilities including a large indoor swimming pool, sauna & gymnasium. Our stay is on a half board basis.

We also take a scenic ride to Stow-On-The-Wold, a delightful market town and the highest of the Cotswold towns standing exposed on 800 feet high Stow Hill at a junction of seven major roads, including the Roman Fosse Way, continuing on to Bourton-On-The-Water, located in a small valley, it straddles the river Windrush with its series of



elegant low bridges, tidy stone banks & traditional Cotswolds buildings. Along with a visit to Stratford Upon Avon, the birthplace of William Shakespeare, steeped in culture and history. Set in the beautiful rural Warwickshire countryside, on the banks of the river Avon.

Three Ways House Hotel, Chipping Camden

Three Ways House Hotel, Chipping Camden, set against the backdrop of the rolling Cotswold Hills and nestled in the quaint honey stoned village of Mickleton, it has established itself as a warm, welcoming, comfortable and quirky Cotswold village hotel. Truro's most striking feature is the Cathedral, with its green spire and gothic appearance. Built at the turn of the century it dominates the Truro skyline with its 250ft high towers. The city's heritage is as a market town and port dating back over 800 years, booming during the tin mining era. Sat at the head of a navigable stretch of the River Fal, Truro was within easy reach of the sea but more protected than Falmouth downstream. During our stay we shall travel via Marazion for some fine views of St Michaels Mount, and onto Penzance, a coastal town, steeped in history, with its long sweeping promenade, continuing on to pretty St Ives, a quaint town with a golden sandy beach and colourful cottages. We also visit Falmouth, which has been shaped and influenced by its strong connection to the sea. Combining a fascinating maritime heritage, modern creativity and bustling cobbled streets, continuing on to Trebah Gardens, the magical essence of a sub-tropical Cornish garden, steeped in heritage, creativity and the spirit of innovation.

Discover the magic of this beautiful Cornish valley garden, with over four miles of footpaths. Explore under canopies bursting with exotic blooms and follow vibrant tunnels of colour that cascade down to it's very own secluded beach on the Helford River.

The Alverton Hotel

The Alverton Hotel, Truro, is a beautifully unique, Grade II listed hotel and has stood on its hillside setting since 1830 within the Cornish capital city of Truro. 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Isles of Bute, Mull & Iona – Scotland

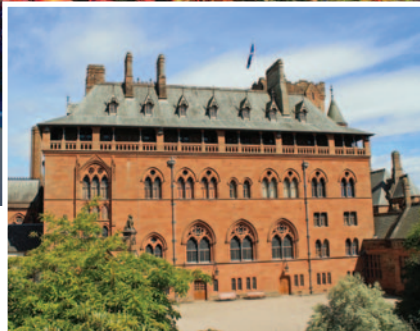
Wednesday 9th June - 6 days ~ 5 nights

A chance to view the beautiful west coast scenery of Scotland on this island tour. Travelling on the coach and ferries offers an appealing opportunity to view the wonderful coastline and offshore islands as we explore the history & culture of the Inner Hebrides. Our adventure begins with a journey up to Scotland and we will spend our first night at The Radstone Hotel in Larkhall, before continuing on to Oban to catch the ferry over to the Isle of Mull. We have two nights here, at The Isle of Mull hotel, which allows us plenty of time to take in the magnificent scenery on our coach for an island tour, calling at Tobermory, the main town on the island, with its colourful harbour setting. Throughout the islands, there is evidence of a captivating past. From early Viking settlers to stories of the Spanish Armada. Ancient sites, dramatic historic monuments and evocative deserted townships. There are centuries of history to uncover. We travel as foot passengers on the ferry from Ross of Mull over to the legendary Isle of Iona, known as the "cradle of Christianity", Iona has an atmosphere of peace and tranquillity, and is the burial site of ancient Scottish Kings. We travel back

to Oban on the ferry and visit Inveraray, a traditional county town of Argyll, with an inclusive admission to Inveraray Jail and courthouse, now an award-winning museum that graphically recounts prison conditions from medieval times up until the 19th century. From here, we head to our final hotel, The Riverside Lodge Hotel, Irvine, for a two night stay. From here, we head to Wemyss Bay to catch the ferry over to Rothesay on the Isle of Bute, renowned for its glorious gardens & grand architecture. We have an island tour with an inclusive admission into Mount Stuart House & Gardens, an outstanding and flamboyant Victorian, Gothic style mansion with beautiful gardens all set in a 300 acre estate.

The Radstone Hotel

The Radstone Hotel, Larkhall, is a spacious and unique hotel with a modern stylish design and dynamic atmosphere. All of the guestrooms are en suite and offer the usual refinements including TV, WiFi, telephone & refreshment facilities. Our stay is on a half board basis.



Isle of Mull Hotel & Spa

Denbies Wine Estate was established in 1986 and now competes on an international level, including multiple gold awards for sparkling wine production. We have included an 'Indoor Vineyard Tour' The tour starts in the brand new flat screen cinema featuring 'The Vineyard Through the Seasons'. Learn about the geology and history of the estate and experience the changes in the vineyard through the seasons and appreciate the wine making process from vine to bottle. Our walking tour Passes through the working winery with a full commentary and you will see the equipment used in today's wine production. With particular emphasis on the sparkling wine disgorging line installed in 2013. The journey ends in the atmospheric Denbies cellars where you will be guided through a tasting of Denbies classic wine. Our hotel, Federation House, continues on this boozy theme, with our "Private Dining Experience" which includes a specially selected menu created by the chef and



accompanied by the appropriate wine for each course as suggested by our specialist host for the evening. After a sumptuous breakfast (and possibly some paracetamol) we visit RHS Wisley, one of the world's greatest gardens, packed with horticultural inspiration. Wisley is the historic home of the RHS and houses one of the largest plant collections in the world. Stroll through the Jellicoe Canal & Wisteria Walk or just relax in the Mediterranean Terraces.

The Federation House Hotel & Conference

Centre, Leatherhead, is a stunning architectural award-winning venue. All of the guestrooms are en suite & offer the usual refinements including TV, telephone, hairdryer and WiFi & refreshment facilities. Our stay is on a half board basis.

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Shetland & Orkney Isles

Thursday 29th July - 6 days ~ 5 nights

So, what awaits you in Orkney and Shetland? For starters, each has a distinctive culture, natural wonders and a number of fascinating geological sites. Lying off Scotland's north coast, surrounded by crystal-clear waters, these two archipelagos are rather special places indeed. Travelling north into Scotland on our outward journey, to our first overnight hotel in Pitlochry. Our second day takes us via Inverness and into the North of Scotland to Dornoch for a further overnight stay. Travelling onward to Scrabster, where we join our first ferry, the MV Hamnavoe, for a 90 minute sailing, passing Britain's highest vertical cliffs and the Old Man of Hoy. Once we arrive at Stromness, we meet our local guide for a tour on our coach of the World Heritage sites of Skara Brae, Stones of Stenness, Ring of Brodgar, Skaill House, Churchill Barriers, Italian Chapel & Scapa Flow. We enjoy a three course evening meal in a local restaurant, before departing on our ferry from Kirkwall. After arriving the following morning in Lerwick, we join our local guide for a tour of The Shetland Isle, visiting the outstanding site of Jarlshof in the south and Scalloway Castle and Museum, returning to our ferry for our evening meal and overnight sailing to Aberdeen. Once back on dry land, we make our way to the Scottish Borders to our final overnight hotel.

Fishers Hotel Pitlochry, is steps from Killiecrankie and features rooms with views over the city. Since 1897 the venue has been offering accommodation in a 4-story building with a historic architecture and furnishings. All of the guestrooms are en suite and offer the usual refinements including TV, WiFi, telephone & refreshment facilities. Our stay is on a half board basis for one night. A lift serves all floors.

Dornoch Hotel is set in its own grounds in a truly historic corner of the Scottish Highlands, overlooking the esteemed Royal Dornoch Golf Course and bordered by pristine beaches and forestry walks. All of the guestrooms are en suite and offer the usual refinements including TV, WiFi, telephone & refreshment facilities. Our stay is on a half board basis for one night.

North Link Ferries, all accommodation on board NorthLink Ferries ships have been built with your comfort in mind.
