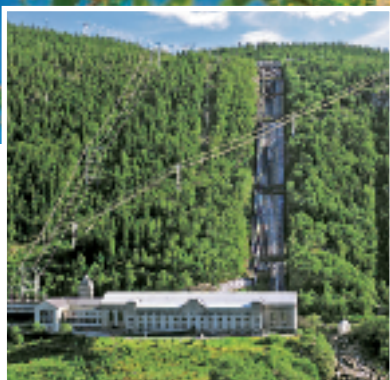

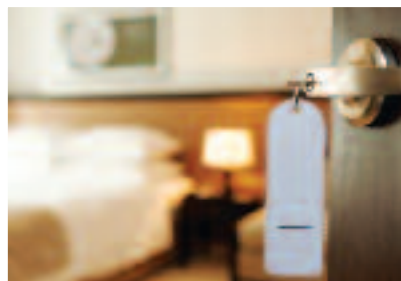

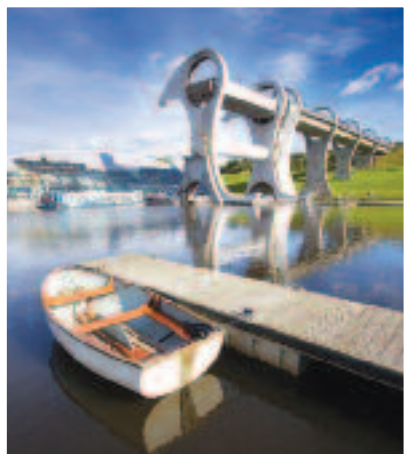

Memories in the Heart of England

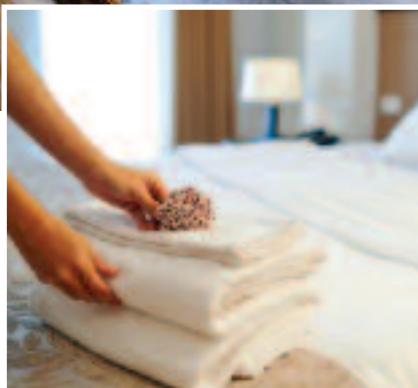
